Sun, Mar 22

Arrive Los Angeles

Transfer on your own to our hotel. Rest of day free.

Mon, Mar 23 **Lights, Camera, Los Angeles! (B,L)**

Begin our exploration in the downtown district with its wonderful architectural mix of gleaming high-rises alongside historic treasures. Stop at **Olvera Street**, the city's birthplace, for lively mariachi music and the vibrant colors of Old Mexico. Then to **Beverly Hills**, home of the rich and famous. Drive down infamous **Rodeo Drive** past toney designer shops. Lunch at the historic **Pig'n Whistle**, a 1927 landmark serving light California Cuisine in an "old Hollywood" setting, before travelling back to the golden era of the movies as we visit **Hollywood**. Shuttles between hotel and arena for the *Ladies' Short Program* (A & B). Evening: *Ice Dance Final, Awards*.

Sat, Mar 28
